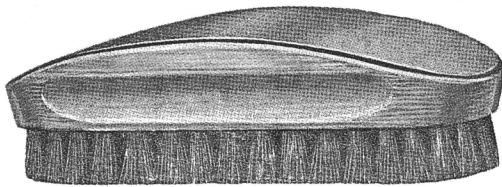


# BRUSHES, HAND



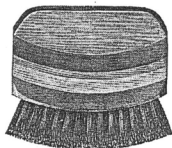
## BOOT BRUSH



4

For scrubbing or washing uppers. Stiff black bristle, 5/8-inch trim. Block size, 5 3/4-inches x 2 1/4-inches.

## TREERS' BRUSH

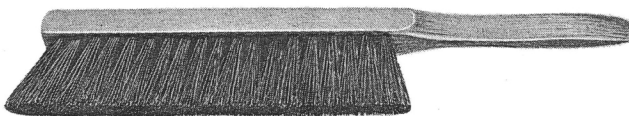
Short, stiff bristle. Chiseled for removing dust between upper and sole on welt shoes. Two grades — No. 1 (stapled) and No. 5320 (wire drawn.) No. 5320 is stiffer than No. 1.

## BENCH DUSTERS

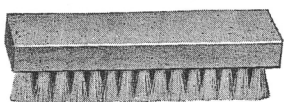
Black horsehair fill stapled to hardwood back with handle. Overall length 14 inches. Brush section 4-inches long and 2-inches wide (5 rows). 2 1/2-inch trim.



4229

Pegged brush with tampico and horsehair fill and hardwood handle. Staple construction. Overall length 15 1/2-inches; trim 2 inches.

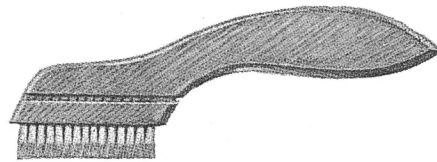
## HAND SCRUB BRUSH



Stiff tampico brush for general purpose cleaning. Stapled construction.

## WELT BRUSH



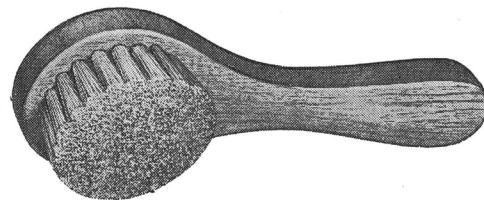
4300

4300 — Two rows white bristle, 1/2-inch trim.

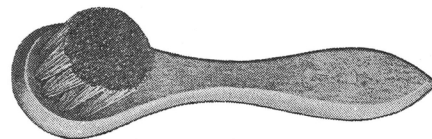
5204 — Three rows black bristle, heavier than 4300 for men's work. 1/2-inch trim.

## SHOE DAUBERS



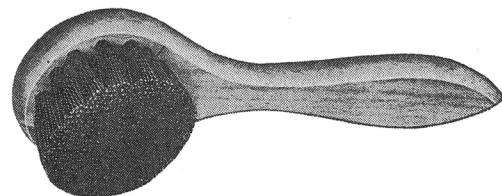
350 Black horsehair

7 5/8" x 2 5/16" block, 1" trim.



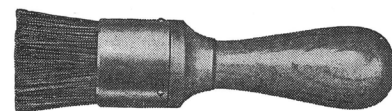
9 Black horsehair and synthetic bristle

6" x 1 5/8" block, 7/8" trim.

12 Grey horsehair and synthetic bristle
